2018 was a banner year for Spectrum Designs Foundation. We continued to increase sales, retain satisfied customers, gain new clients and offer more opportunities for individuals with Autism. Our visual work place advanced, fostering independent work and an efficient flow to our production. We are very proud of what the organization has achieved this past year, first and foremost, to help more individuals with Autism lead full and productive lives through the world of work. In 2018, we were able to employ 23 individuals and offer 15,000 hours of meaningful employment to individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Our business model continues to foster conversation in myriad industries, who reach out inquiring about how to replicate this model. Discussions are underway in earnest to expand Spectrum Designs to Westchester, NY.

In March, we opened the doors to our 7,500 square foot flagship location at 366 Main Street in Port Washington, NY. This milestone was the culmination of a successful capital campaign and a tremendous year for our three major events. The new facility has tripled our production space and our hiring capability. In May, the documentary film, *This Business of Autism* premiered to a sold out crowd. The film has been screened at twelve U.S. film festivals, sharing our story and offering hope for a new way to support and employ our friends with Autism.

Spectrum Bakes' gourmet granola is offered in staff breakrooms and at corporate events for our Spectrum Designs clients. Spectrum Suds has grown in reputation and repeat, pleased local customers.



2018 brought with it a brand new warehouse space at 366 Main Street.

This allowed us to offer "Shell" production to Autism Speaks. This meant that all 30,000 Autism Speaks Walk program shirts were stored, printed, and shipped from our building for the first time. This allowed us to keep our staff super busy through the quieter winter months and cut production times on these orders in half for the rest of the year.
